Arch "Beaver" Aplin, III, President of Texas-based Buc-ee's stores, earned a Bachelor of Construction Science at Texas A&M University in 1980. In the summer of 1982, he opened his first Buc-ee's in Lake Jackson, Texas. Over the last 40 years, he has built a chain of destination travel centers dedicated to providing an elevated experience for the driving public through service and selection.

Passionate about community involvement, Aplin has a long history of being active at the local and state levels. He is the former Chairman of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission, a board member of The Association of Former Students at Texas A&M, a member of the Lieutenant Governor's Transportation Advisory Board, and a member of the Governor-appointed ERCOT Board Selection Committee.

He received the M.B. Zale Visionary Merchant Award, the 2012 Outstanding Alumni Award from the Texas A&M University School of Architecture, the 2022 McLane Leadership Business Award, and most recently, the 2023 Friend of Wildlife Award. Previously, he was a 9-year board member of the Brazosport Independent School District, including a two-year tenure as board president.

Aplin and his wife, Joanie, reside in Texas and have five children.

Eddie Block is a partner at Republic National Distributing Company with over 50 years in the wine and spirits industry.

Eddie's father founded Block Distributing Company in San Antonio in 1939 and Eddie began his career working at Franchise Liquors, a subsidiary in Denver. He returned to San Antonio to work for Block Distributing directly and served as its president for 17 years. Block Distributing later merged with Republic Beverage Company and Eddie served as its vice-chairman.

He has served on the boards of industry organizations, including Wine & Spirits Wholesalers of America and the Licensed Beverage Distributors of Texas. He was awarded the American Beverage Licensees' Top Shelf Award, a high honor presented by America's beer, wine, and spirits retailers to those who have demonstrated professional excellence in the industry while positively impacting their communities.

As a member of the Greater San Antonio Chamber of Commerce and the area's Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, Eddie has helped to improve San Antonio's business community. He has participated with many other community organizations, including San Antonio's Jewish Federation, where he was a board member, the San Antonio Area Foundation, the United Way Tocqueville Society, the McNay Art Museum, the University of Texas Health Science Center, the Cancer Therapy & Research Center of San Antonio, and the Baylor College of Medicine.

Alan Dreeben is a partner at Republic National Distributing Company in San Antonio, Texas. Founded in 1939 by his father-in-law, Eddie Block Sr., as Block Distributing Company, today RNDC is a family-owned business that has evolved into one of the nation's leading wholesale alcoholic beverage distributors, encompassing 40 markets coast to coast with revenues of \$13 billion. Alan joined the company in 1966 and was mentored in wine sales by his father-in-law. He retired from the Board of Directors in 2022 and is now a member of the RNDC Advisory Board.

Alan is actively engaged in several business and philanthropic activities. He served in many leadership roles at Wine and Spirits Wholesalers of America, the industry's national membership organization advocating on federal and state regulatory issues. In 2017 the WSWA honored him with the Lifetime Achievement Award, and this year will recognize him with the Inaugural Industry Legacy Award.

With a long history of commitment to education at all levels, Mr. Dreeben served as a Foundation Director and past regent and chairman with the Texas State University System. He is a member of the University of Texas Development Board and was a member of the Executive Committee of the UT System Chancellor's Council. He served as president and trustee at the McCombs School of Business, which inducted him into the McCombs Business School Hall of Fame in 2015, and is a member and past chair of its Advisory Council. He was a trustee at The University of the Incarnate Word, which awarded him an honorary doctorate. He was also awarded an honorary doctorate from Texas State University. He has held several positions with the Alamo Heights ISD in San Antonio, including past president, trustee, and director of its foundation.

In addition, Alan has held leadership positions in more than 20 community and religious organizations, including Any Baby Can, Hospice of San Antonio, the Council on Alcoholism, the McNay Art Museum, the Santa Rosa Children's Hospital Foundation, United Way, and Temple Beth El. Alan is a graduate of The University of Texas at Austin and received his MBA at Harvard University (Executive Program).

## CHAIRMAN, SILVER VENTURES FORMER CHAIRMAN, PACE FOODS SAN ANTONIO

Kit Goldsbury is the Chairman and Founder of Silver Ventures (SV), a San Antonio-based private investment company. In 1969, Kit joined Pace Foods as one of a two-person prep line. A decade later, he was named president. In 1995, as Pace's Chairman, Kit sold Pace Foods to Campbell Soup Company.

He later founded Silver Ventures. In 1998, SV purchased a fledging tomato company, Desert Glory. Today known as NatureSweet, it is the leading producer of greenhouse-grown tomatoes in North America, employing 7,000 full-time, year-round associates.

In 2002, SV acquired the 22-acre Pearl Brewery. Kit saw its potential to revitalize the neighborhood and the San Antonio River's reach and to preserve the area's historic architecture. The once derelict, abandoned industrial site is now a bustling neighborhood home to chef-driven restaurants, independent retailers, 650 residences, 30 companies, the #1 year-round farmers market in the country, and the nationally recognized Hotel Emma, a 5-star designated hotel. Pearl is recognized as one of the most successful urban and environmental revitalization efforts in the U.S.

In 2008, Kit partnered with The Culinary Institute of America to address the underrepresentation of Mexican Americans in restaurant leadership. Together, they opened the Institute's third campus at Pearl – with programs committed to promoting Latin cuisines, culinary techniques, and diversity in the hospitality industry. Kit created the El Sueño Scholarship to increase accessibility to all students – 90 percent of whom receive financial aid. Its 1,100 graduates have changed the city's local food scene and helped to make San Antonio the second UNESCO Creativity City of Gastronomy in the United States.

Kit is a San Antonio native and a graduate of Trinity University. He is widely respected for his philanthropic contributions to major institutions and community initiatives in the San Antonio area. Kit remains the visionary and creative force behind the ever-evolving Pearl district.

Janet Gurwitch is a highly successful corporate executive with over 25 years of experience in the beauty industry. She is currently an operating partner with Advent International, a Boston-based private equity firm, where she focuses on the beauty and wellness consumer sector. Gurwitch is the founder and former CEO of Laura Mercier Cosmetics & Skincare, a global brand of high-end niche cosmetics. Gurwitch managed and oversaw Laura Mercier's day-to-day business operations, strategy development, and retail negotiations.

Gurwitch joined forces with famed makeup artist Laura Mercier in 1996 after realizing the imminent paradigm shift in the beauty industry that was propelling niche lines to the forefront of the cosmetics business. The combination of Gurwitch's business savvy and foresight coupled with Mercier's talent provided a solid foundation for a strong, growing business based on technique and a high-quality product. She sold Laura Mercier in 2008.

Prior to founding Laura Mercier, Janet Gurwitch was the Executive Vice President of Neiman Marcus, where she established the merchandising strategy from 1992-1995.

Today, Gurwitch is an investor in and on the Board of Directors of Olaplex (OLPX) and the Houston Astros baseball team. She formerly served on the boards of consumer brands Tatcha, Drybar, First Aid Beauty, Dollar Shave Club, and Urban Decay Cosmetics as well as the public company La-Z-Boy.

Gurwitch's personal community involvement includes the President's Leadership Council for Houston Methodist Hospital; trustee for The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston; chairing the Hermann Park Conservancy dinner event in 2018; and chairing the Community In Schools' (CIS) annual event in 2015. She has also served as Underwriter for the Drawing Institute for the Menil Collection, and she's an avid supporter of the Houston Symphony and Houston Grand Opera.

Daniel Lubetzky is a social entrepreneur passionate about channeling business forces to achieve social good. The son of a Holocaust survivor, he strives to prevent what happened to his father and others from happening again.

While best known for founding and growing KIND Snacks into a multi-billion-dollar global brand, Daniel's foray into food was the unexpected outcome of his work to use business to bring neighbors in Middle Eastern conflict regions together.

He conceived of civic movements OneVoice and now Starts With Us to give voice and agency to the majority of citizens who favor common sense solution-building over hateful divisiveness. Through his business-building and investment platform Camino Partners, Daniel and his team partner with entrepreneurs to co-found, launch, and build new ventures (like Mexican food brand SOMOS) — and also take meaningful positions in entrepreneur-led ventures building value with values.

Daniel is a member of the Anti-Defamation League's Inaugural Board of Directors. He has received awards from The King Center, World Economic Forum, Skoll Foundation, Conscious Capitalism, Hispanic Heritage Foundation, and Horatio Alger Association. Daniel was named a Presidential Ambassador for Global Entrepreneurship by President Obama. He is the author of The New York Times bestseller Do the KIND Thing and a recurring shark on ABC's television series Shark Tank.



JACK MARTIN
CHAIRMAN, JPM COMPANIES
FOUNDER, PUBLIC STRATEGIES
DALLAS

Jack Martin is an entrepreneur, businessman, and rancher. He is perhaps best known for his behind-the-scenes advice to C-suite executives, navigating them through strategies for dealing with their most complex challenges.

Early in his career, Jack served as Executive Assistant to U.S. Senator Lloyd Bentsen of Texas. He remained one of the Senator's most trusted advisors and friends throughout his career. In 1988, Jack founded Public Strategies, which grew into one of the most successful corporate advisory firms in the world. Under Jack's leadership, Public Strategies helped shape the business climate in Texas and beyond. In 2006, WPP Group acquired Public Strategies and merged it with Hill & Knowlton, a 90-year-old global communications company. Jack was appointed Global Chairman and CEO of the combined entity – Hill+Knowlton Strategies – where he took his business advisory services global by leading the multinational firm with over 80 offices in 44 countries.

Upon stepping down from Hill+Knowlton Strategies, Jack formed JPM Advisory, LLC as part of a family investment platform active in ranching, oil and gas, and entrepreneurial endeavors. Jack and his wife Patsy both come from fourth generation Texas families involved in agriculture. Today they own the JPM Ranch Company which includes the Mallard Creek Ranch in Montague, Texas, and the historic Open C Ranch in Forestburg, Texas. Currently, Jack serves as Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Baylor Scott & White Health, the largest not-for-profit health care system in Texas and one of the largest in the United States with 52 hospitals and over 40,000 employees.

Jack is a graduate of Texas State University. In 1985, he was appointed to a six-year term on the Board of Regents of the Texas State University System, and in 1988, he was elected chairman of the Board of Regents. He was honored as a Texas State University Distinguished Alumni in 1991.

James is the co-founder and CSO of Longhorn Life Sciences, a biotech startup focused on needs-based innovation. Currently, the company is prototyping a post-surgical bandage aimed at remotely sensing infection-prone wound sites—a technology that has received over \$147,000 in non-dilutive funding. James is also currently a PhD candidate in Physics at UT Austin where he studies the role of feedback and control theory in life. 


