MICHAEL M. BOONE

Co-Founder and Senior Counsel, Haynes Boone
Dallas

Mike Boone and his mentor, Richard D. Haynes, co-founded the law firm of Haynes Boone in 1970. Since then, it has become a global firm with over 700 lawyers and offices in 17 U.S. cities, plus London and Shanghai. In 2011, *The American Lawyer* magazine selected Mr. Boone for the prestigious Distinguished Law Firm Leader Award in light of his firm's growth, professional achievements, teamwork culture, and steadfast commitment to public service.

Mr. Boone has been personally recognized for his excellence in the field of law. He has more than 50 years of experience in handling complex mergers and acquisitions, major corporate finance transactions, and challenging board of director representations. In 2010, the *Texas Lawyer Magazine* selected him as one of the 25 greatest Texas lawyers of the past quarter century and as the "Go to Lawyer" in Texas in the field of corporate law.

Mr. Boone is widely known for his civic engagement and philanthropic involvement, most notably in the fields of education and human services. He has served as President of the Highland Park School Board, chaired the Dallas Citizens Council, chaired the SMU Board of Trustees, and served on the board of Abilene Christian University. He has also served as an elder of the Preston Road Church of Christ.

In Honor of his impressive advocacy of public education, the Highland Park School District named an elementary school after him in 2019. In recognition of his civic and charitable service, he has also been awarded the J. Erik Jonsson Ethics Award from SMU's Cary M. Maguire Center for Ethics and Responsibility; the Spirit of Generations Award from the Senior Source; the Methodist Health System Foundation's Robert S. Folsom Leadership Award for public service in the greater Dallas area; and the Justinian Award for Community Service by the Dallas Lawyers Auxiliary.



JOE GEBBIA

Co-Founder, Airbnb; Co-Founder, Samara
Austin

Joe Gebbia is the co-founder of Airbnb. An entrepreneur from an early age, he is obsessed with igniting new ideas. Most people don't know that Joe began his life as an artist, eventually double majoring in graphic design and industrial design. While studying in the Northeast, Gebbia complemented his creative pursuits and studies at Rhode Island School of Design (RISD) with business coursework at Brown University and MIT. After moving to San Francisco, Gebbia worked as a designer for Chronicle Books where he experienced first-hand how a design-led business worked, department by department. His favorite spot is at the intersection of business and design.

Airbnb's groundbreaking service began in his San Francisco living room in 2008. Today, Airbnb has spread to nearly 7 million listings in over 220 countries, changing how people trust each other. His latest venture, Samara, comparably cemented in economic empowerment, housing resources, and design, produces fully customized, factory-made homes designed for rental income, a place to house family, work from home, or pursue an interest.

Gebbia has spoken globally about both entrepreneurship and design and received numerous distinctions such as the *Inc.* 30 under 30, giving a TED talk, and speaking at Wired and Fast Company. He loves to find opportunities to give back on the local and global level and has joined the Giving Pledge to commit more than half of his wealth to philanthropy. He contributes his time via other board seats at Airbnb and Tesla.



KATHLEEN S. HILDRETH
Co-Founder, M1 Support Services
Denton

Kathleen Hildreth is the co-founder of M1 Support Services—a military aviation services company she has grown 100% organically to over 7,000 employees with nearly a billion dollars in annual revenue. M1 has supported the Department of Defense in over 70 domestic and overseas locations.

Throughout her 40-year career, Hildreth has gained national attention and accolades for her government and management expertise. In 2019, she became the first and only Veteran named to *Forbes'* list of "America's Richest Self-Made Women"—a list she has remained on since. She was also recognized by *Forbes* in its coveted "50 Over 50" list in 2023.

Hildreth graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1983 and was named one of its Distinguished Graduates in 2024. She was commissioned as an Aviation officer—flying VIPs in Korea then serving as a Maintenance Test Pilot at Hunter Army Airfield before removing her Captain's uniform in 1988. Hildreth served in positions of increasing responsibility with Fortune 500 companies before co-founding M1 Support Services, headquartered in Denton, Texas.

Since 2020, she has served on the board of the Wounded Warrior Project. Passionate about a wide variety of Veteran causes, she has supported the Medal of Honor Museum, the Military Women's Memorial, numerous military family scholarship funds, and many other local and national charities serving Veterans and their families.

In addition to her B.S. from West Point, Hildreth earned a Master of Education degree from Georgia Southern University.



DAVID B. MILLER
Co-Founder and Managing Partner, EnCap Investments
Dallas

David B. Miller is a Co-Founder and Partner of EnCap Investments, the leading provider of private equity capital to the oil and gas industry.

Miller attended Southern Methodist University on a basketball scholarship and played for the Mustangs' 1972 Southwest Conference Championship team. He received his BBA and MBA from SMU in 1972 and 1973.

Miller has served on the Board of Trustees at SMU since 2008 and currently serves as Chairman. He received Distinguished Alumni Awards from both SMU and the Cox School of Business and was honored with the Silver Anniversary Mustang Award by the SMU Lettermen's Association.

Miller began his career as an energy lender with Republic Bank of Dallas. In 1980, he co-founded MAZE Exploration, where he served as Co-CEO until its sale in 1986. In 1987, he partnered with legendary oilman Frank Pitts in the formation of PMC Reserve Acquisition Co.

Amid a global energy crisis, Miller wrote the business plan for and co-founded EnCap Investments. EnCap has raised 25 funds and managed \$43 billion. It has been instrumental in the formation, capitalization, and growth of 250 independent energy companies.

Miller is a member of the National Petroleum Council and has been inducted into the Rocky Mountain Oil and Gas Hall of Fame, the Dallas Business Hall of Fame, and the *Oil and Gas Investors* magazine's Hall of Fame. He received the L. Frank Pitts Energy Leadership Award from the Maguire Energy Institute.

Miller serves on the Boards of Directors of the George W. Bush Foundation, UT Southwestern Medical Foundation, Methodist Health System Foundation, and National Association of Basketball Coaches Foundation. He has chaired the Boards of Goodwill Industries and The Senior Source of Greater Dallas. He was honored with the Volunteer Center's Lifetime Achievement Award and recognized by the Methodist Health System Foundation with the Robert S. Folsom Leadership Award.



DAVID ROBINSON

Co-Founder, Admiral Capital Group; Co-Founder, The Carver Academy; Minority Owner, San Antonio Spurs
San Antonio

David Robinson was named one of the 50 greatest players in NBA history and was a ten-time NBA All-Star. He led the San Antonio Spurs to 1999 and 2003 NBA Championship Titles, and during his time in the league, he was named the NBA Most Valuable Player (1994-95), Defensive Player of the Year (1991-92), and Rookie of the Year (1989-90). He is a two-time Olympic Gold Medalist and is the all-time leader in U.S. Olympic basketball history in career points, rebounds, and blocked shots. Robinson was inducted into the International Basketball Federation (FIBA) Hall of Fame in 2013.

In addition to his decorated career in the NBA, David and his wife Valerie created the David Robinson Foundation in November 1992. David has raised close to \$40 million for The Carver Academy (TCA), an independent school designed to serve pre-K through eighth-grade students in San Antonio, Texas. In 2012, TCA partnered with IDEA Public Schools as its first school in San Antonio, and the network has since grown to 30 schools reaching over 10,000 students in San Antonio.

In 2007, David Robinson and Daniel Bassichis, formerly of Goldman Sachs, founded Admiral Capital Group. Built around Robinson's long-standing values and integrity, the framework for Admiral's sustainable business model brought together an interest in private equity and a desire to make a positive impact.



TAYLOR SHERIDAN

Film & TV Creator, Writer, Director, Producer, Bosque Ranch Productions; President, Four Sixes Ranch
Fort Worth

Taylor Sheridan is an Academy Award®-nominated screenwriter, Emmy®-nominated producer, and the creator, writer, director and executive producer of multiple record-breaking Paramount Network series including YELLOWSTONE, MAYOR OF KINGSTOWN, TULSA KING, 1923, 1883, and LIONESSE. A new series, LANDMAN, which Sheridan co-created and executive produced, is set to premiere on Paramount+ on November 17, 2024. The series stars Billy Bob Thornton, Jon Hamm, and Demi Moore, and is a modern-day tale of fortune-seeking in the world of oil rigs.

Sheridan currently has numerous projects in various stages of development and production: LIONESSE returned for its second season on October 17, 2024 on Paramount+ and YELLOWSTONE premiered the second half of season five on November 10, 2024 on the Paramount Network. Sheridan's latest project, THE MADISON, stars Michelle Pfeiffer, Kurt Russell, Matthew J. Fox and Patrick J. Adams and is a heartfelt study of grief and human connection following a New York City family in the Madison River valley of central Montana.

Sheridan made his debut as a writer/director with his critically acclaimed film WIND RIVER, the conclusion to his modern frontier trilogy, in 2017, earning Best Director honors at the Cannes Film Festival. He previously wrote HELL OR HIGH WATER, a drama which was nominated for four Academy Awards®, including Best Picture and Best Original Screenplay.

Sheridan owns and operates two Texas ranches including the legendary Four Sixes (6666) Ranch and Bosque Ranch. He also recently opened the Four Sixes Ranch Steakhouse at the Wynn Hotel in Las Vegas, a pop-up restaurant featuring Sheridan's own Four Sixes Ranch Brand Beef, which retails premium quality beef sourced from 6666 and a network of various ranches.

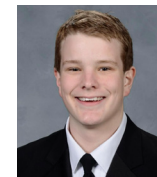
